


## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

1. Do you offer SC Alive at 25?
  - a. No, we do not offer this course. We will post upcoming classes on our Facebook page. This class is needed for students who attend public school. You cannot receive a parking pass without this course.
2. Do you have to have your permit to attend your class?
  - a. No, you can attend our 8-hour class at 14 years old. We offer the permit test for students who are over 15 years old. Our permit testing takes place after each teen driver training class at 4pm.
3. Can I drive with an expired permit?
  - a. If your permit expires, please go to the nearest DMV to renew the permit. If it has been over 9 months after the expiration date you will have to take the permit test again.
4. Do I need any money for lunch during the 8- hour class?
  - a. No, we provide lunch, snacks and drinks for our students.
5. Do you allow payments on your services?
  - a. Yes, we allow parents to make payments on the Teen/ Adult Driver Training Packages. We ask that you bring \$100 deposit on the day of the class. Parents will pay off the balance as we drive. Private Driving payments are due before each session.
6. Do you offer the insurance reduction class?
  - a. Yes, we offer the class for insurance reduction, Point Reduction and Mature Driving Course. We have you covered on insurance reduction certification.

7. What do I need to bring to class?
- Please bring your \$100 deposit if you didn't register online, your permit if applicable, parent/ legal guardian will need to sign some paperwork on the day of the class. If you want to pay in full for the course, you may do so. We will make your driving session schedule during class so please know when you are free to drive.
8. Do we drive with other students in the car?
- No, when we drive with our students, there is only the student and the instructor in the vehicle. Student are allowed to take breaks during their driving session. Our cars are equipment with cameras to insure safety for our students and instructors.
9. How long does it take to finish your driving course?
- That all depends on the student's driving experience and if they have held their permit for 180 days. Most students finish our course between 1-3 weeks after attending the 8 hour class.
10. I have heard that I can take my driving test with you, is that correct?
- Yes, all of our students can take the permit and driving test with us since we are Third Party Testers. Once the student passes a test with us, parents/ legal guardians will have 30 days to take their student to the DMV to turn in their paperwork.
11. I need a PDLA form do you have that?
- Yes, we will provide our students who are 15-16 years old a PDLA form after completion of the course.

12. Do we drive the testing route over and over?
  - a. No, we will drive in the city, rural and interstate areas during our sessions. We will practice all of the maneuvers and items that you need to know for the test.
13. Do I have to bring my child to you for the driving sessions?
  - a. No, we offer pick up/ drop off for students in our driving area.
14. During the 8 hour class will it be boring?
  - a. Of course not! We teach over 3 classes each month and we could not do this if it was boring. We will have lots of fun along with lots of laughs! Students will have a workbook to complete as we watch videos. We will complete some hands-on activities, too. We use curriculum from AAA so you are getting the best and most current information available. We also have impaired goggles for our students to try on during this class. I promise we will have fun while learning how to drive.
